

How to help Ukrainian Refugees in Wetherby



If you would like to welcome a Ukrainian family or individual into your home, please apply via the official Government scheme: Homes for Ukraine Local Sponsorship scheme <https://homesforukraine.campaign.gov.uk/>

Advice when making an application is available locally, including help to identify refugees. Help is also available to settle and support people when they arrive.



If you cannot house a refugee, you may like to volunteer as part of a welcoming team to provide practical help and emotional support for those fleeing the horrors of war.

Offering practical help to settle families will not only benefit those in desperate need but will also strengthen our community by creating new bonds and shared experiences.

If you can help with befriending and everyday activities like filling forms, shopping & banking, help speaking English, inviting for a walk, coffee or meal, or using the bus, we would love to hear from you. Younger people are particularly welcome.
